In 1885 GioBatta Poli moved with his family to Schiavon and opened the tavern "Osteria Al Cappello", knowing that a new railway was in project. A few years later the long awaited little steam train "Vaca Mora" arrived.

The passengers used to wait for the Vaca Mora train in the tavern, sipping that bitter liqueur made by GioBatta by infusing herbs, fruit peels and roots. Sometimes the train driver was coming in, too!

Some sips later, in 1898, from the osteria's premises the Poli Distillery was born.
